

Entrance gates and walls to Lauderdale House

Grade II listed 10 June 1954

The original gates date back to the C18 but the piers were rebuilt when the park was created and are described by Historic England as 'stone capped gauged brick gate piers surmounted by stone urns. Wrought-iron gates with scroll design overthrow and side railings'. Further down the hill by the bus stop, however, the original C18 walls remain.
