

Wrought iron sundial

Grade II Listed 14 May 1974

Historic England date this wrought iron sundial to the tenureship of Sir Sydney Waterlow as the only surviving feature of his formal gardens. Others wonder whether it was installed at a much later date of around early C20 when the park suffered the effects of a heavy storm that saw the loss of many trees and structures in the park. The sundial is a floral clock with the 12 divisions marked out with flowers to tell the hour. The Friends restored the planting in 2010 and have continued to maintain it ever since.
